II. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the RFP. Respondents are directed to take note in their review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

Question 1: Typically, if a project has a railroad crossing located within the limits it will require railroad insurance. This project does not appear to have that requirement. Can

the City consult with the Ann Arbor Railroad to determine what it will require?

Answer 1: This City has inquired with the Ann Arbor Railroad about insurance and has yet to receive a response. The Detailed Specification for Work Near Railroad Crossing and the related pay item "Railroad Protection, at Grade Crossing, Ann Arbor Railroad" will be revised as part of an addendum to address payment for any required railroad insurance and the reimbursement of the associated costs.

Question 2: The request for proposal (RFP) does not list a maximum dollar amount for pay items General Conditions, Project Supervision, and Minor Traffic Control. Typically, the City of Ann Arbor sets a maximum unit price amount that contractors cannot exceed when putting their bids together.

Answer 2: This was an oversight. The Schedule of Pricing/Cost forms in the RPF will be revised to include the maximum unit price amounts for each of these pay items as part of addendum.

Proposers are responsible for any conclusions that they may draw from the information contained in the Addendum.

DETAILED SPECIFICATION FOR WORK NEAR RAILROAD CROSSING

SDA:DAD 1 of 1 05/05/23

- **a. Description.** This work consists of the Contractor consulting with the representative of the Ann Arbor Railroad (herein after called the Railroad) to determine the necessity for, the type of, and cost of protection required for ensuring the safety and continuity of Railroad traffic and payment to the Railroad for protective services when doing work on, above, or below the Railroad property.
 - **b.** Materials. None specified.
- **c. Construction.** Contact the Railroad 30 calendar days prior to starting work in the vicinity of their tracks. Provide documentation to the Engineer with the details of the contact including the person contacted, phone number or email used and the specific time and date. Ensure construction methods are in compliance with the requirements in the contract and as directed by the Engineer.

Pay (or pre-pay when required by the Railroad) the cost for right of entry permit, insurance, flag persons, watchpersons, training, and other protective services and devices furnished or required by the Railroad and made necessary in the judgment of the representative of the Railroad because of the Contractors' operations which are within 50' of each side of centerline of track or impacted by traffic control operations. All Railroad invoices for such protection costs must be paid within 14 calendar days of receipt if not prepaid.

Monitor and provide immediate preference to clearing any traffic which backs up over the crossing resulting from temporary traffic control away from the crossing.

d. Measurement and Payment. Review the accuracy of costs from the Railroad and resolve any inconsistencies prior to submitting to Engineer for reimbursement. Submit satisfactory evidence or certification to the Engineer indicating all bills for protective services and devices furnished by the Railroad have been paid.

The City will reimburse the Contractor for the costs incurred that have satisfactory evidence of payment to the Railroad using the following pay item.
