to center of Washburn Avenue;

along inner rim of Washburn Avenue;

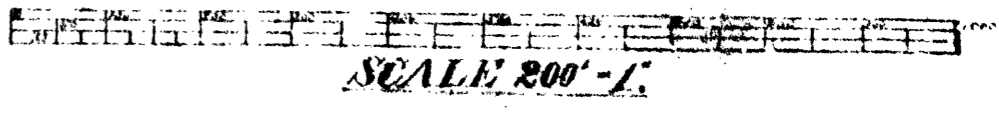
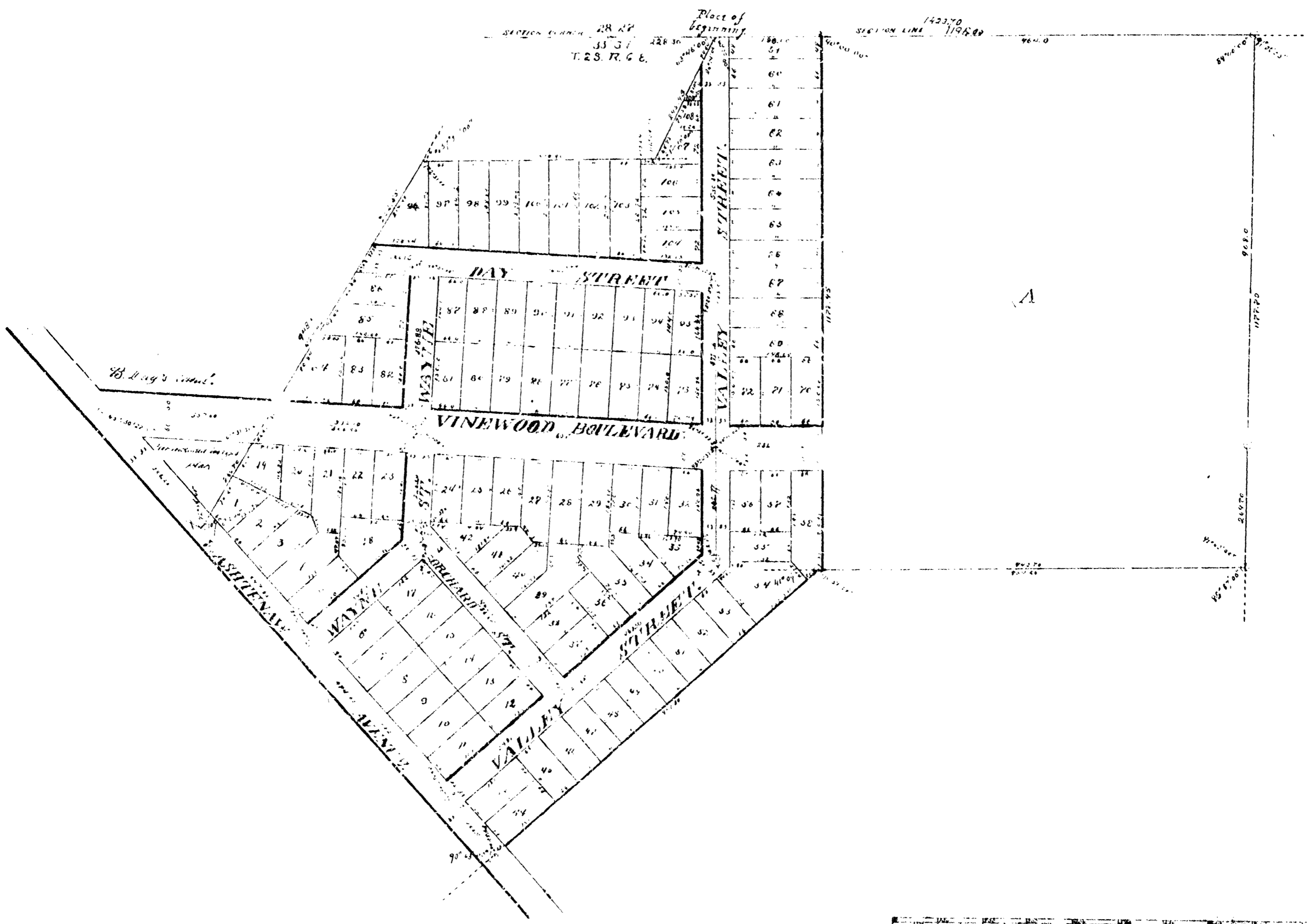
