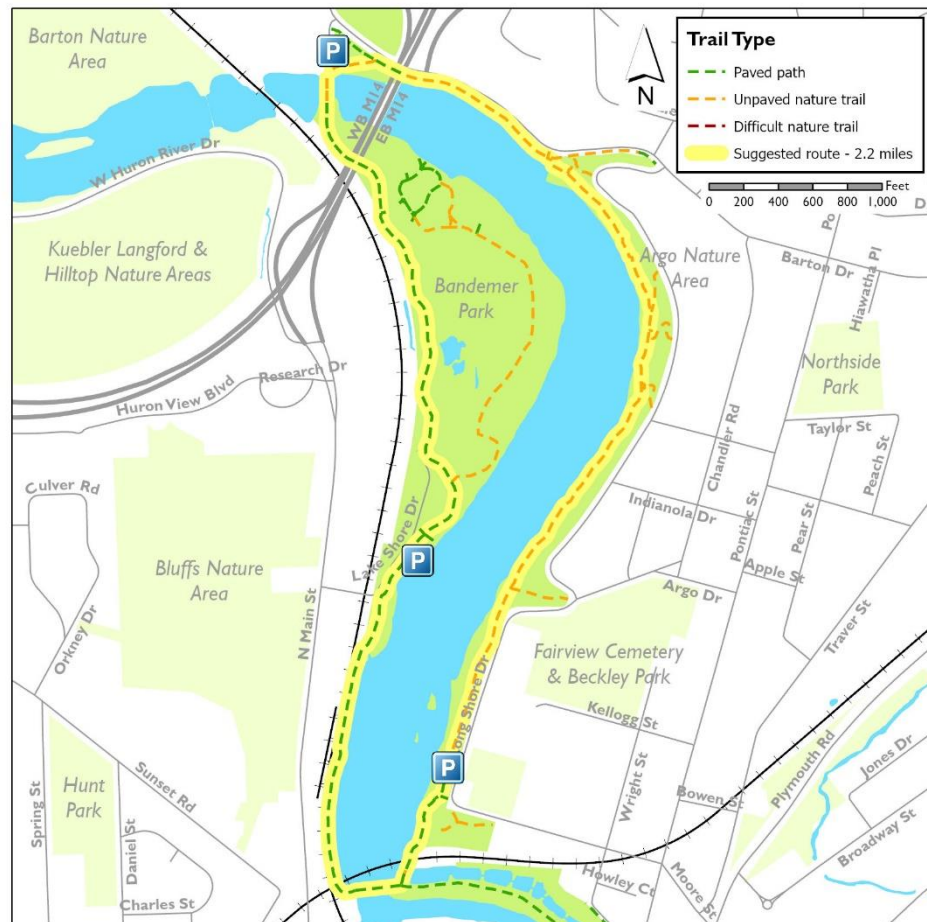
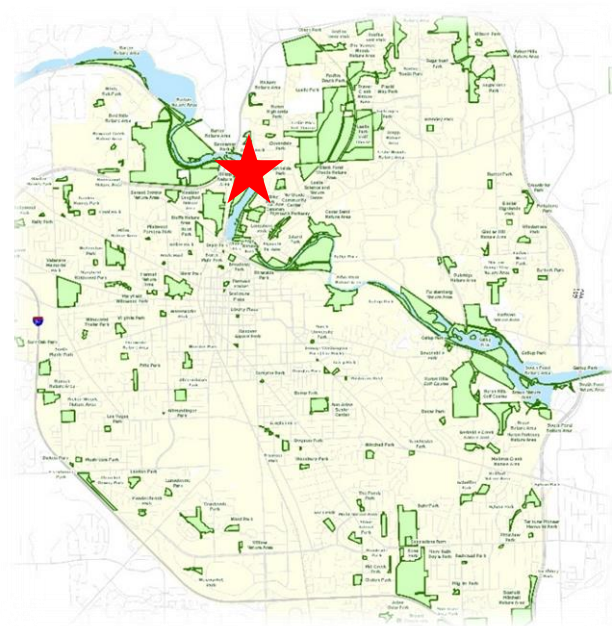




Argo Pond Loop

Celebrate the Huron River! Peaceful views of the river, migrating birds, a woodland trail, a shoreline boardwalk, rowers and scullers practicing, paddlers playing, the excitement of the Argo Cascades . . . there is something for everyone to enjoy on a walk around Argo Pond in Ann Arbor. A 2.25 miles journey will take you through trees and spring wildflowers on an unpaved nature trail through Argo Park with the Border-To-Border Trail (paved) carrying you through Bandemer Park. You will cross the river over Argo dam on the downstream end of the river and upstream at Huron Bridge Park.
