The AAPD is investigating several reports of home break-ins and attempted break-ins at residences across the city. In most of the reported incidents, the intruder is entering the residence through an unlocked first-floor window, using a knife to cut the window screen.

Six incidents have been reported within the past 48 hours (8/29-8/30/23).

In the incident on N. State Street, a female resident confronted the intruder inside a bedroom in the residence at approximately 9:15pm on 8/29/23. The victim described him as a black male, bald, approximately 6'0", thin build, and approximately 40-50 years old. The intruder was wearing black pants, a brown/tan sweatshirt, and a black backpack. The intruder got away with an I-Phone, Bluetooth speaker, as well as some cash. The intruder fled the scene by exiting the front door. The female resident was not harmed. A person of interest has been identified in connection with the N. State Street incident.

We urge all residents in these areas to please lock all windows and doors overnight, especially those on the first floor.
