DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Mallory Addition is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the easterly line of Cambridge Road (formerly New Jersey Avenue) with the north line of Section 33, Town 2 South, Range 6 East, which point is 755.84 feet west of the north-east corner of Section 33, Town 2 South, Range 6 East; thence easterly along the line between sections 33 and 28, a distance of 755.84 feet to the corner of sections 27, 28, 33 and 34; thence deflecting $9^{\circ}31'45''$ to the right along the line between sections 27 and 34 a distance of 195.20 feet; thence deflecting $90^{\circ}00'$ to the right 66.14 feet; thence deflecting $90^{\circ}00'$ to the right 131.85 feet; thence deflecting to the left $89^{\circ}57'30''$ a distance of 199.60 feet to the northerly line of the College Hill Addition; thence deflecting $89^{\circ}19'30''$ to the right 476.88 feet along the northerly line of said addition; thence deflecting $57^{\circ}25'00''$ to the left 214.89 feet along the west line of lot number 96 of said College Hill Addition to the northerly line of Day Street; thence deflecting 612.60 feet to the right 17.97 feet along the northerly line of Day Street; thence curving to the right on the arc of a circle tangent to the northerly line of Day Street and having a radius of 86.61 feet, a distance of 102.16 feet; thence north-westerly along the tangent to the last described line a distance of 1.73 feet; thence curving to the left on the arc of a circle tangent to the last described line and having a radius of 193.13 feet, a distance of 176.47 feet to the intersection of said northerly line of Day Street with the easterly line of Cambridge Road; thence northerly and curving to the left on the arc of a circle having a radius of 165.90 feet forming a part of the easterly line of Cambridge Road, a distance of 164.56 feet - the angle between tangents to said circle and last described circle of Day Street at their point of intersection being $70^{\circ}49'30''$ measured from an easterly to a northerly direction; thence northerly along the tangent to the last described circle 115.65 feet to the place of beginning, being situated in the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 33, T 2 S, R 6 E, and N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34, T 2 S, R 6 E, Michigan.


